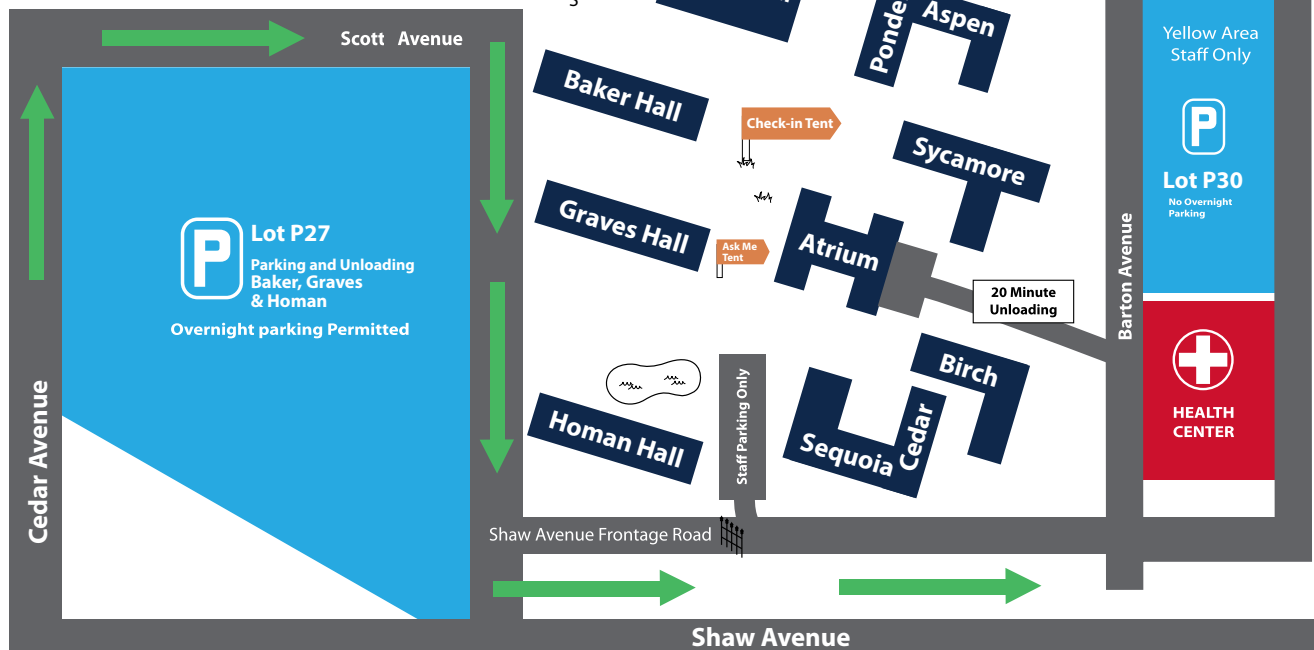

Vaccinations

- All Housing students will need to complete a simple COVID-19 Self-Certification form through the University that will be available on your student portal beginning Monday, Aug. 2. Fresno State students must complete this certification prior to your scheduled move in on Aug. 19, 2021.
- When you certify that you are vaccinated, you will need to also upload your vaccination record (with documentation of at least the first dose) by Aug. 17, 2021. Any student who is not fully vaccinated by your scheduled move in date and time will need to provide housing staff a negative COVID-19 test and continue to test until fully vaccinated. You will need to submit your updated vaccine record documenting your second dose by September 30, 2021.
- If you are not yet vaccinated, our Student Health and Counseling Center in partnership with the Nursing Department will offer five (5) **free vaccination clinics** beginning Aug. 9. Free community resources are also available; find a clinic through myturn.ca.gov or schedule an appointment with your health care provider.
- For students who seek either a medical or religious exemption, the University will require mandatory, regular COVID-19 testing. You will need to provide a negative COVID-19 test at your scheduled move in time, taken within the last 72 hours. We will provide more details soon about the frequency and campus location for the COVID-19 tests that will be required for unvaccinated students.

Meal Plans

- The University Dining Hall (UDH) is open from 7:00am until 9:00pm, Monday through Thursday, 7:00am-8:00pm Friday, and 10:00am to 8:00pm on Saturday and Sunday.
- Students have the option to pre-order their food and pick it up to-go through the Fetch app throughout the day.
- There are three meal plans at Fresno State Student Housing. Platinum, Gold, and Silver (Returning residents only). Unused meals roll over from week to week, but not from semester to semester.
- Each plan comes with flex cash which provides residents with \$150 (\$200 for Silver Plan) per semester on their Fresno State Student ID card to use at any open on-campus restaurant.
- If you find that you need to adjust your meal plan, you can submit a Meal Plan Change Request the week of September 13-17, 2021.



Receiving and Sending Mail

When you check-in, you will receive your personal mailbox assignment. The mailboxes are located in the halls for community-style and in the Atrium for suites residents. Outgoing mail can be placed at each hall desk or in the Atrium.

Financial Information

An invoice for your room and meal plan will be sent to your Fresno State email. This original invoice will reflect the entire academic year amount (August through May). Starting August 2, 2021 your Fall semester amount will appear on your Fresno State Portal for payment. Fall semester room and meal plan charges will be broken into 4 installments. First installment will be due no later than September 5, 2021.

Payments will be accepted online or at either the housing office or Joyal Cashiers window.

Choose from one of the following online payment methods:

E-Pay (electronic check) through My Fresno State

Credit Card Payments using SmartPay

There is a 2.65% service charge on all payment transactions when using this method. Fresno State accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express through SmartPay.

- Financial aid will apply directly to the room and board charges on your portal. You will be responsible for any amount not covered by your financial aid.
- You can pay the amount in full or make multiple payments. The installment amounts will need to be paid no later than the 5th of each month to avoid a late charge being assessed.
- Spring semester room and meal plan charges will be placed on your Fresno State student portal in January 2022.
