Standard Features

What not to bring

- Alcohol or alcohol containers (Exception: alcohol for 21 and older is permitted)
- Amplified musical instruments
- Candles, incense/plug ins, heaters
- Controlled substances - illegal use or possession
- Cooking appliances (Hot plates, toasters, etc.)
- Dartboards
- Hookahs, e-cigs, etc.
- Hoverboards
- Motorized vehicles or gasoline-powered equipment to store or work on inside your room
- Pets other than aquatic fish (Max. five gallon tank)
- Weapons including, but not limited to firearms, fireworks, ammunition, knives, paintball guns, pellet guns, airsoft guns
- 3D printers

Things to Know

Parking Permits

Parking is relaxed on move-in day, but for the remainder of the year it will be enforced 24 hours-a-day in all on-campus parking lots. To use any of the available student lots, you can purchase a day pass for \$5.00 or visit [online](#) to buy either a fall-only or fall/spring pass.

Bikes

If you plan to bring a bike to campus, register it with the campus police department by filling out this [bike registration form](#). As a resident, you will have access to the bike barns which are only accessible with your housing key.

Mail

When you check in you will receive your mailbox assignment and combination. Suite mailboxes are located in the Atrium and community mailboxes are located in each community lobby.

Package Lockers

Our touchless package lockers (located in the Atrium) make it easy to receive larger parcels. Download the Parcel Pending app to get started.

Safes

You will receive your safe combination at check-in, which can be changed to your own combination later. Safe dimensions are 2 in wide x 16in deep x 9in tall. Safes are located in each bedroom closet.

Water and Ice Machines

Filtered water stations are located in the Atrium and in each community lobby. An ice machine is located in the Atrium.

24 hour service desk

The service desk is available to residents at all times for any questions or concerns. Check out a vacuum, volleyball, game table equipment, and lock out assistance.

Fitness Center

The fitness center is exclusively for student housing resident use and is open 24/7. Access an array of treadmills, free weights and other workout gear.

Pool

Our pool is open March to October from 10 am to dusk. Access is for residents only. No lifeguard on duty.
